- 1. Rainbow emblem 2. Sm. Masonic emblem or pin 3. Sm Eastern Star emblem or pin
- 4. Sm. house or similar 5. Two sm. garden tools 6. a white candle (3 inches) 7. a gold ring
- 8. Sm. American Flag with staff 9. Sm white cross

5 red flowers and one white flower to form cross at the head of the Bible

songs: Star Spangled Banner; Dear Lord, Father of Mankind; Face to Face; Faith of our Fathers; The Father that means the most to Me; The Lord's Prayer

Worthy Advisor- "Sister Drill Leader, you will present our Flag at the Altar."

Drill Leader presents Flag.

Worthy Advisor- "You will join me in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of our country, followed by one verse of our National Anthem."

Worthy Advisor- "I wish to welcome everyone here this evening. It gives _______ Assembly a great deal of pleasure to exemplify a degree tonight for our Fathers. In the past it has been the custom to honor each Mother by exemplifying the Mothers' Degree. Tonight we will try to show you that we have not forgotten another person, equally dear to us, our fathers.

The Worthy Advisor takes a red flower and goes to the Altar.

Worthy Advisor- "I hope that as this flower rests upon the Altar beside the Bible, it will remind each father as he hears the words of this degree, given in the deepest sincerity, will know they are meant especially for him, whether he be the father who is a Mason, a father who is an Eastern Star, or the father of a Rainbow Girl." Places flower on the Altar.

All return to their stations.

"On this White Altar that reflects its rays of Faith and purity through the pages of the Holy Bible, I place this red flower as a symbol of the living Father and may the sun never set that I am not thankful for all that He has done for me." As I place this red flower on the Altar, I am indebted to him whose candle of Faith never burns out." Return to station

Worthy Advisor- "Sister Chaplain, you will lead us in prayer."

Chaplain- "O heavenly Father, bestow Thy blessings upon each Father of the world tonight that they may understand that their constant toil and service for mankind will never go unnoticed. Make them feel confident that we know in this world today we could not have happiness, security, or freedom, if it were not for them. Also, teach us, as their daughters, never to say one unkind word or sharp remark, but rather to be always ready with a kind thought, a sincere word, and a pure deed. It is to you, dear Lord, that we are especially grateful for placing such a wonderful friend as a Father on this earth, and may we never take his name in vain. Amen. "

Places gold ring on the Altar.

Patriotism- "The Flag of our country is loved and respected by every living American. Many fathers have not only cherished it, but have also been called upon to stand strong and firm in its defense so that it will continue to represent their patriotism and our freedom. May this Flag of Red, White, and Blue never again be stained with the blood of war, but rather let it wave in peace and tranquility."

The greatest of these services is represented by this white cross, that of giving of their lives for us; for us who represent our country. No one can ask for a greater service than giving of ones life which thousands of Fathers have done in the past.
