MISS SERVICE Award for Rhode Island Grand Assembly

Requirements:

- 1. Must have been in Rainbow for more than two years as of the application deadline.
- 2. Must have a minimum of twenty-five hours of service within the year prior to application (May 1, 2023-April 30, 2024).
- 3. Must provide the names and contact information of non-parental adult supervisor(s).

To apply, you should be able to:

- 1. Attend all Grand Assembly and Grand Officer functions next year.
- 2. Chair a hands-on Statewide Service Project related to the Grand Worthy Advisor's term (eg. Charity/Service, theme) with the advice of a Grand Executive Committee member.
- 3. Be willing to speak about service and the Service project.

Submit these 3 documents to the Supreme Deputy by May 15th:

- Complete the Miss Service application including record of service hours from May 1, 2023 April 30, 2024 which is attached in this email
- Include a letter of recommendation which states your ability to fulfill your obligations of this award.
- Submit one to two paragraphs indicating why you would like to be Miss Service as well
 as describing a possible service project. If you are selected as Miss Service, you may
 choose an alternate project.


SUPREME SERVICE PROJECT





Happy 2024,

We have another update on our Membership Program "Get Pumped" Here's the top 10 jurisdictions as of February 1st.

We want to first recognize Bolivia for their participation. What great numbers they have to share with us. Since August of 2022 Bolivia has reported their girls have earned 302 red shoes.

In looking even closer at this data, 197 girls have earned all 7 colors of shoes for their bracelets. They also reported over 33,000 hours of service. What a testimony to our organization around the world. We congratulate these girls for their outstanding achievement.

If you do not pre-register, you may compete IF time allows.

- Proficiency = say ≥97% of the words from the piece of ritual correctly with acceptable presentation (see next page for blank score sheet)
- 2. Dress Code: For Individual, follow dress code for Grand Representatives Day. For TEAM, teams are encouraged to dress in matching outfits, such as decorated t-shirts or matching outfits head to toe. Matching outfits must still meet the Rainbow dress code but can be casual.
- 3. If desired, you can compete in more than one category. This includes participating individually as well as part of team.
- 4. At Grand Assembly, each participant will be given their score sheet to assist them in future competitions.

If an individual achieved "Proficiency" they will receive a pin corresponding to the color of the level!
